Enrollment Summary for Autumn 2015 New Undergraduate Students

BACKGROUND

A summary of admissions outcomes and enrollment projections for Autumn 2015 new undergraduate students for each of the three campuses was presented to the Academic and Student Affairs (ASA) committee in July 2015.

The attached report provides an update on final enrollment of new undergraduate students for each of the three campuses as of the "10 day" census.

Per the 2015-16 ASA Annual Planning Calendar, comprehensive graduate/professional and transfer student enrollment and demographics will be provided to the ASA committee in January and May, respectively. Beginning in July 2016, admissions and enrollment information for all student categories will be provided to the Board comprehensively.

NUMBERS IN CONTEXT

Highlights and enrollment trends for each campus.

UW Seattle

- The final freshman class is the largest ever at 6,792 with 4,283 Washington residents.
- A record number of underrepresented students enrolled in the 2015 freshman class.
- The freshman application pool increased by +16.5% overall.
- Both the size and the academic profile of the freshman applicant pool for the Seattle campus increased significantly this year.
- Autumn 2015 saw another record number of applications in all residency categories
- Early indications are that we will have another record number of freshman applications for autumn 2016.

UW Bothell

- UW Bothell's number of undergraduate underrepresented minority students are at an all-time high.
- Fall 2015 marks the 10th year of continuous growth since UW Bothell began admitting first year students in Fall 2006.
- Both underrepresented minority students and first generation students have steadily increased over the past 10 years.
- UW Bothell's fastest growing programs are in STEM and health-related fields, with majors increasing from 324 (25% of students with declared majors) in 2006 to 1440 (47% of students with declared majors) in 2015-16.

UW Tacoma

- Record enrollment for Fall 2015.
- Largest first-year cohort in UW Tacoma history
- 56% of undergraduates identify as other than Caucasian, 26% identify as underrepresented minority.
- 64% of first year students coming directly from high school are first in their family to attend college.
- Transfer students comprise 58% of total enrollment.
