




Seattle – Freshman Applications by Residency (Applied)

Seattle - Freshman Applications by Residency Autumn 2017-2021




Seattle – Freshman Applications by Residency (Admitted)






Seattle – Transfer Applications by Institution Type

Seattle – Transfer admits by Institution Type





- The freshman class includes a record number of underrepresented students


> Transfers

- Despite ever-lower enrollments at Washington community colleges (WACC), resulting in fewer WACC transfer applications, we continue to enroll over 1,200 WACC transfer students each year
- The transfer class includes a record number of underrepresented students
- Admission for transfer applicants from WACCs is still accessible with an overall admit rate of 69%




Bothell – Freshman Applications by Residency




Bothell – Freshman Admits by Residency






Bothell – Transfer Admits by Institution Type



> Freshman

- Record number of applications driven by WA residents and slight rebound in international
- Yield rates dropped across all residence types Seattle application overlap increased from 75% to 80%
 - Declines in Latino admit rate and yield
 - Declines in "2 or more" applications, admit rate and yield

> Transfers


- Continued decline in applications significant this year as CTC enrollment declines have started to roll through
- URM climbed to a record high primarily due to declines in enrolled white students (% and absolute)

Overall Bothell had its second highest Autumn enrollment ever




Tacoma – Freshman Applications by Residency




Tacoma – Freshman Admits by Residency








Tacoma – Transfer Admits by Institution Type



Tacoma — 2021 FRESHMAN CLASS AND 2021 TRANSFER CLASS OBSERVATIONS

> Freshman

- 12.5% up in applications, resulting in a slight increase in Freshman enrollment
- First Gen (50.2%) and URM (36.0%) both represent a decrease in underserved populations, but still a significant percentage of our incoming Freshman students
- The disproportionate impact that COVID has had on our student population is showing up in our enrollment numbers

> Transfers

- Applications and admits down, resulting in 8.5% decrease in transfer enrollment the downstream effect of the impact COVID has had on our feeder institutions
- First Gen (57.7%) and URM (31.4%) both represent an increase in underserved transfer student populations
- We continue to see growth in the School of Engineering & Technology and Biomedical Sciences
- Our overall enrollment is down 340 (6.3%)
- UWT attracts a significant number of BIPOC, lower-income, and first generation students—populations disproportionately impacted by the pandemic.
